Apples marked as cooking/cider are primarily used for cooking and/or cider making.

Dual purpose apples may be used as dessert apples and cooking or cider making.

The cherries originate from St Dominic. Many of the other varieties originate from Cornwall.

The majority of the trees were planted in January 2024 by about 20 volunteers using pre-dug holes. Most of the trees were supplied by Endsleigh Gardens Nursery in pots and planted with vole and deer guards. They were watered during dry spells during the first summer and mulched with wood chip. Initially the trees were about 1.5m tall.
